

Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Sri Krishna Sai Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **196 Point Chevalier Road, Point Chevalier, Auckland**, and known as **PT CHEV ORGANIC WINES**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Sunday to Wednesday **10am to 9pm**
Thursday to Saturday **10am to 10pm**
- (c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (d) There shall be no display of ready to drink (RTD) products within view of the front entrance and windows of the premises.
- (e) There shall be no externally facing advertising of alcohol products or brands on the shop frontage and windows area and no such advertising on signs outside the premises other than the trading name of the business.
- (f) There shall be no single sales of:
 - (i) Beer or ready to drink spirits (RTDs) in containers of less than 400ml in volume except for craft beer.
 - (ii) Shots or pre-mixed shots.
- (g) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.
- (h) The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence expires at the close of 16th May 2022 unless renewed.
